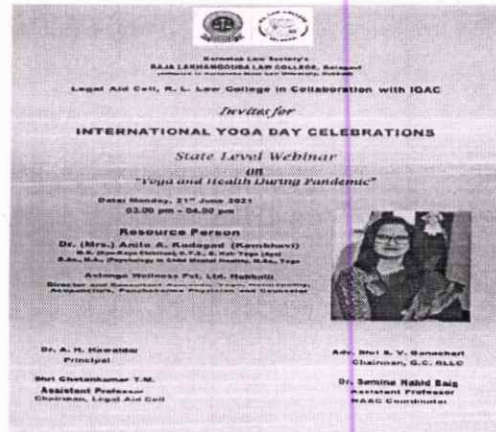


Report of the Legal Aid Cell
