

Only on receipt of the detailed programme schedule (Session-wise with names of the Resource Persons) subject to approval of the same by the Commission, advance part payment of the sanctioned amount will be released. Please inform us in whose favour / Designation & Address only in whose name A/c of the Institution is maintained (the cheque has to be sent. Once again, I take this opportunity to thank you for the proposal and looking forward for more interaction in promotion of Human Rights.

4. It may be considered on the priority basis as the programme has to be completed well in time, as well as the Utilization Certificate (GRR 19-A form only) along with detailed Expenditure Statement duly audited and signed by the authorized signatory, Detailed Programme Report, Vouchers in original, List of Participants & Resource Persons, Photographs, Video Recording of the programme, Feedback Forms etc. of the programme must be submitted within 20 days from the commencement of the same, so as to settle accounts of the Commission.
