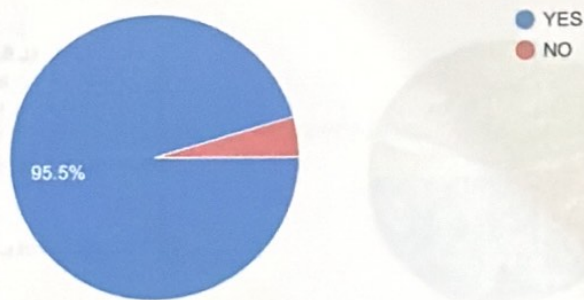
1. Are you aware that the curriculum (Law Subjects) is prescribed by Karnataka State Law University, Hubballi?

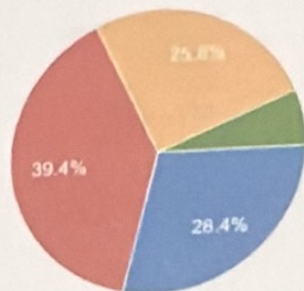


2. Are you aware of the Subjects available to you in the Course Syllabus?

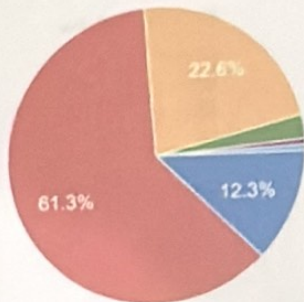


3. Interest generated by Teacher regarding syllabus is

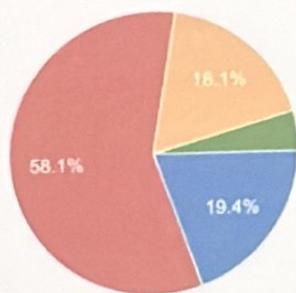

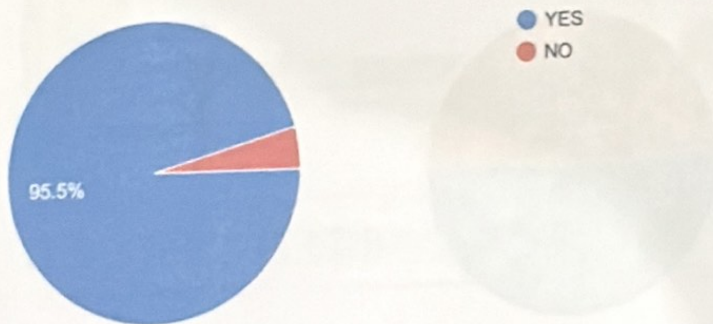

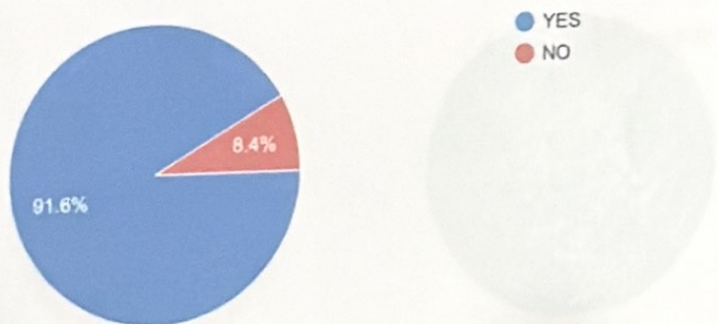

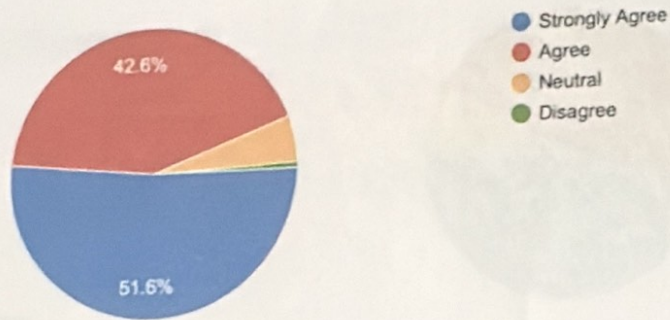

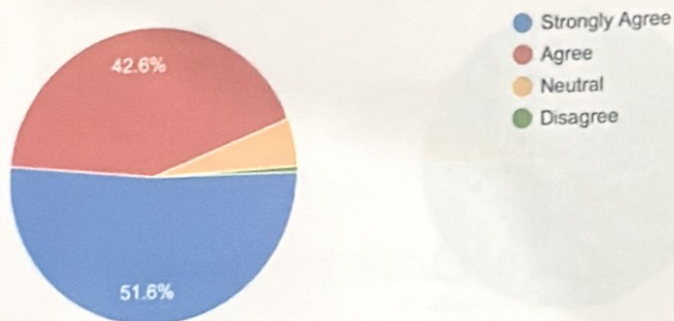

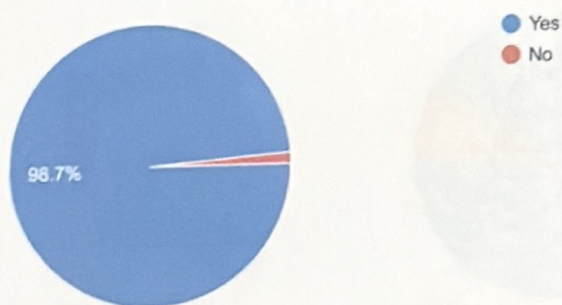

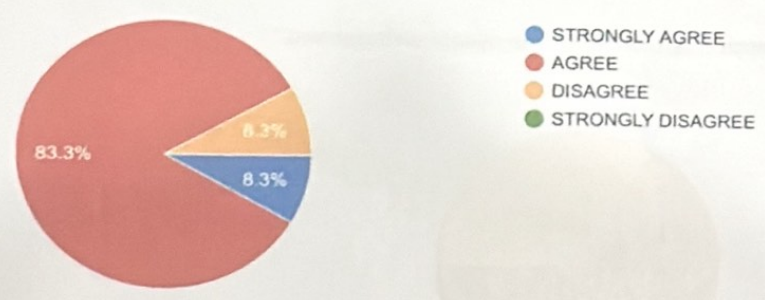

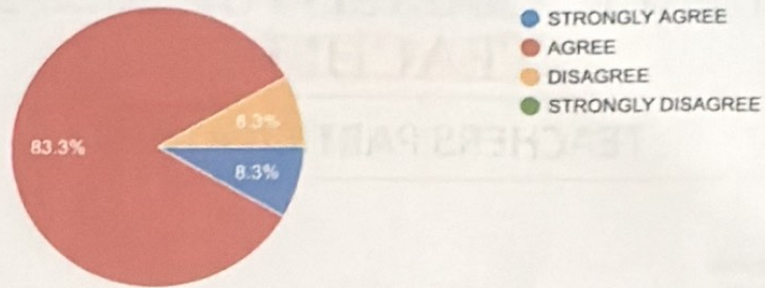

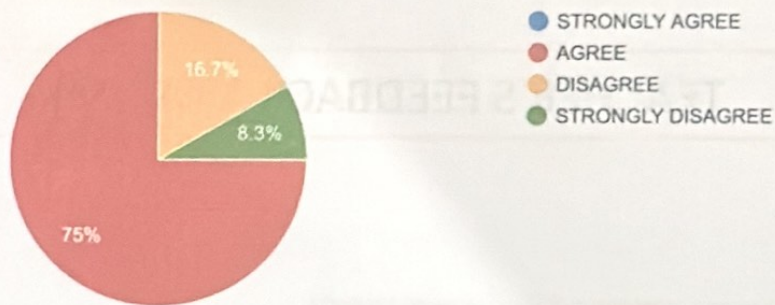
Do you agree that the current syllabus is need based?

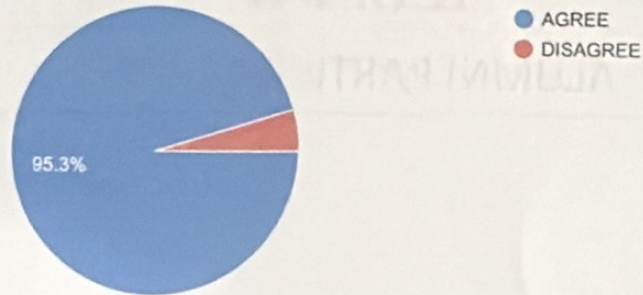

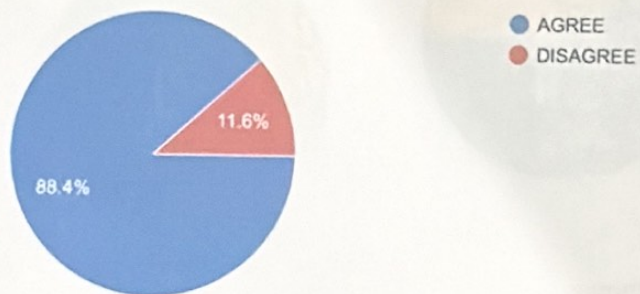
Do you agree that the Law Course Curriculum has intellectually stimulated you?

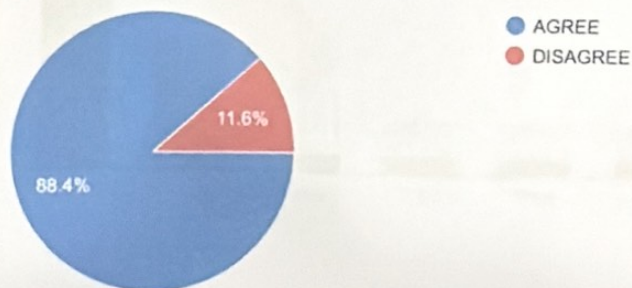

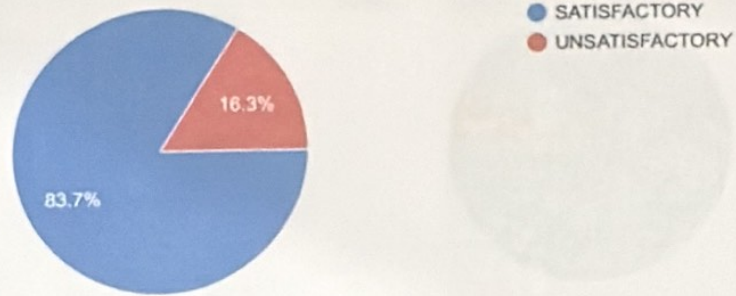

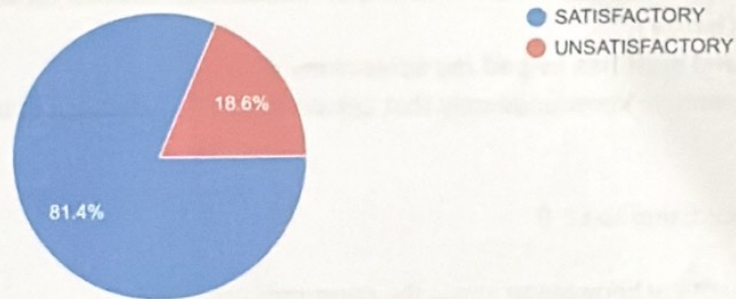

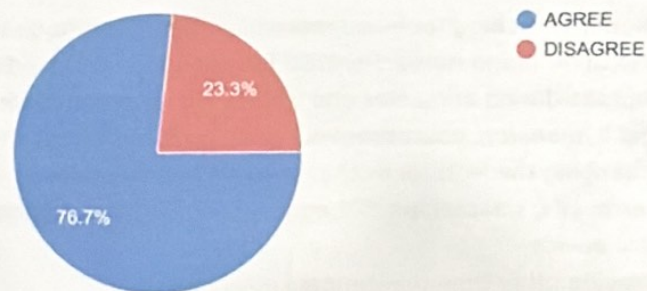

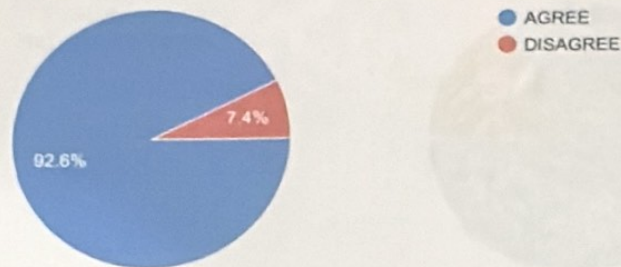

As we are affiliated to your esteemed University, we would like to submit the feedback taken from our students, alumni and teachers on the curriculum prescribed by the University.


Below are some issues identified by the stakeholders which we would like to submit for your kind perusal:
