



*The common purpose of this memorandum of understanding is to enhance knowledge pool and augment the existing resources for the benefit of the stakeholders of both the institutions.*

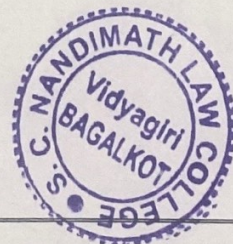

“Presidency University – School of Law” and “Raja Lakhamgouda Law College” or, wherever the context requires, hereinafter singly referred to as “Party” and jointly referred to as “Parties”.

## PREAMBLE



- A. Presidency University – School of Law is ceaselessly engaged in disseminating legal education and moulding legal professionals since its inception. Established in 2015, School of Law has carved out a niche for itself as one of the young top law schools in India, and is ranked as such.
- B. Raja Lakhamgouda Law College is one of the first law colleges in Karnataka and has been actively engaged in shaping young legal professionals since November 1939.
- C. Whereas, Presidency University, School of Law and Raja Lakhamgouda Law College are desirous of establishing academic collaboration with each other in the areas of law, management studies, and social sciences, and thus promote a vibrant academic culture of teaching, research and publications have entered into this Memorandum of Understanding.

## I. SCOPE OF AGREEMENT

The Memorandum of Understanding is for the purpose of Academic Collaboration that will encompass exchange of students and members of faculty between the two parties as well as other academic activities, research and publications. In addition to this, active efforts will be made to develop joint training and research programmes that will be pursued in a collaborative spirit. Some of the collaborative areas include the following: -

### TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF COOPERATION / COLLABORATION: -

1. Raja Lakhamgouda Law College and School of Law, Presidency University, shall collaborate in mutually agreeable academic events, teaching, training and research, wherever feasible. Such collaborations will be based on mutually agreeable terms and conditions specifically agreed for each of the collaborative efforts.
2. Raja Lakhamgouda Law College and School of Law, Presidency University, shall offer full time regular as well as optional courses to the under-graduate level offered at these institutions from time to time on mutually agreeable terms and conditions;
3. Faculty members from each of these institutions shall be invited for important seminars, conferences. The financial implications shall be worked out on a case to case basis;





4. Those modalities for a similar exchange of faculty members will be laid down through mutual discussions that should be made operational for a period of five years.
5. Faculty, and students of both the institutions are welcome to make use of the library resources of each other and to have academic interaction with the faculty.
6. Any financial implications emerging out of such collaborations (other than the fees of the students etc.) shall be worked out and decisions will be taken with mutual agreements.

## II. AREAS OF COOPERATION


This Memorandum of Understanding expresses a mutual desire by Raja Lakhamgouda Law College and School of Law, Presidency University to co-operate in building intellectual and research capacity and scholarship. Additional areas of co-operation may be added by written consent of the two Parties. Both Parties will act in good faith to ensure that the objectives in this Memorandum of Understanding are realized.

## III. TENURE OF THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Progress in realizing the terms and conditions referred to herein will be reviewed periodically at such mutually agreed intervals and the Memorandum of Understanding may be amended at any time by mutual consent and in writing. Both parties reserve the right to terminate this Memorandum of Understanding at its convenience, without assigning any reasons, by issuing to the other party six months written notice. The implementation and/or continuance of programmes or projects established pursuant to this Memorandum of Understanding prior to the Effective Date of termination shall not be affected by the termination of this Memorandum of Understanding.

## IV. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY AND CONFIDENTIALITY

1. In respect of each project and programme of co-operation, the Parties shall negotiate and mutually agree in writing on their respective rights to intellectual property and commercial exploitation of the same (including without limitation, trademarks, and service marks, copyrights, patents, design and confidential information pertaining thereto).
2. Neither Party shall, at any time disclose to any third party any confidential information of the other party which is acquired in the course of activities under this Memorandum of Understanding, a collaborative project or a programme, without the prior consent of the other party in writing. Neither Party shall, without the prior written consent of the disclosing Party, make use of the confidential information disclosed to it other than for the purpose as agreed herein.





3. The confidentiality and non-use obligations contained herein will not apply to information which are already in the public domain except in breach of this Memorandum of Understanding; information in the possession of the receiving Party prior to the disclosure of the information which the receiving Party can show, at time of receipt hereunder, was already in its rightful possession; information which is independently developed by the receiving Party, which the receiving Party can show was independently developed by such of its personnel / employees who had no knowledge of the information disclosed by the disclosing Party; information required to be released by law, and information which is rightfully received by the receiving Party from third party without any breach of confidentiality obligation.

## V. NON-BINDING NATURE OF MEMORANDUM



Nothing in this Memorandum of Understanding shall be construed as creating any contract, partnership, agency or other legal relationship between the parties. This Memorandum of Understanding is only a non-binding statement of intent to foster genuine and mutually beneficial collaboration.

## VI. TERMINATION

1. This Memorandum of Understanding shall come into force immediately upon its signature by the parties.
2. The validity of this Memorandum of Understanding is initially for a period of five years from the date of its execution and the same can be further extended on mutual agreement.
3. The Memorandum of Understanding can be terminated by the either of the parties by giving advance notice of six months and without jeopardizing the coursework or registration of any of the students of either institution.

## VII. GENERAL MATTERS

1. Both the Parties will work out detailed plans of implementing this Memorandum of Understanding. Both Parties shall designate suitable and competent personnel from their respective Institutions in order to effectively coordinate and achieve the intended objective of this Memorandum of Understanding.




